

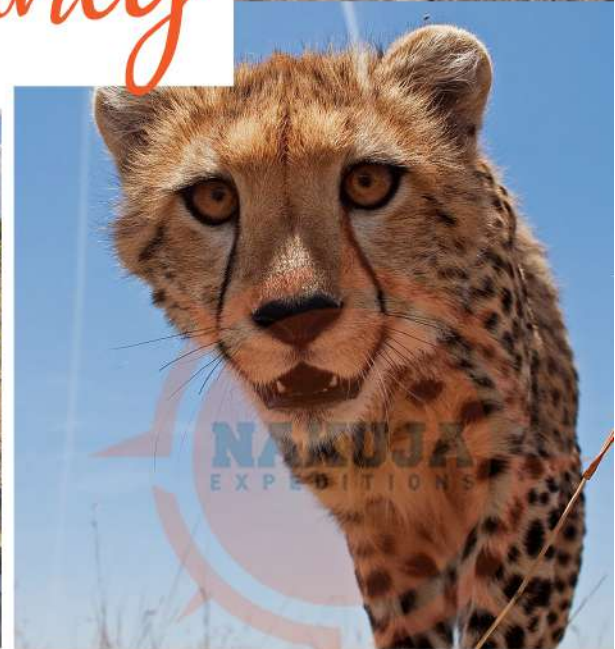

Safari vehicles must serve several purposes: they must allow you to sit in comfort for game drives, offer excellent viewing opportunities, and be tough enough to withstand the demands of the Tanzanian wilderness.

The safari vehicles are fully equipped with radios, bottled water, field guides, binoculars and other amenities for comfort and safety.

7- A roof hatch provides open views and easy photography.

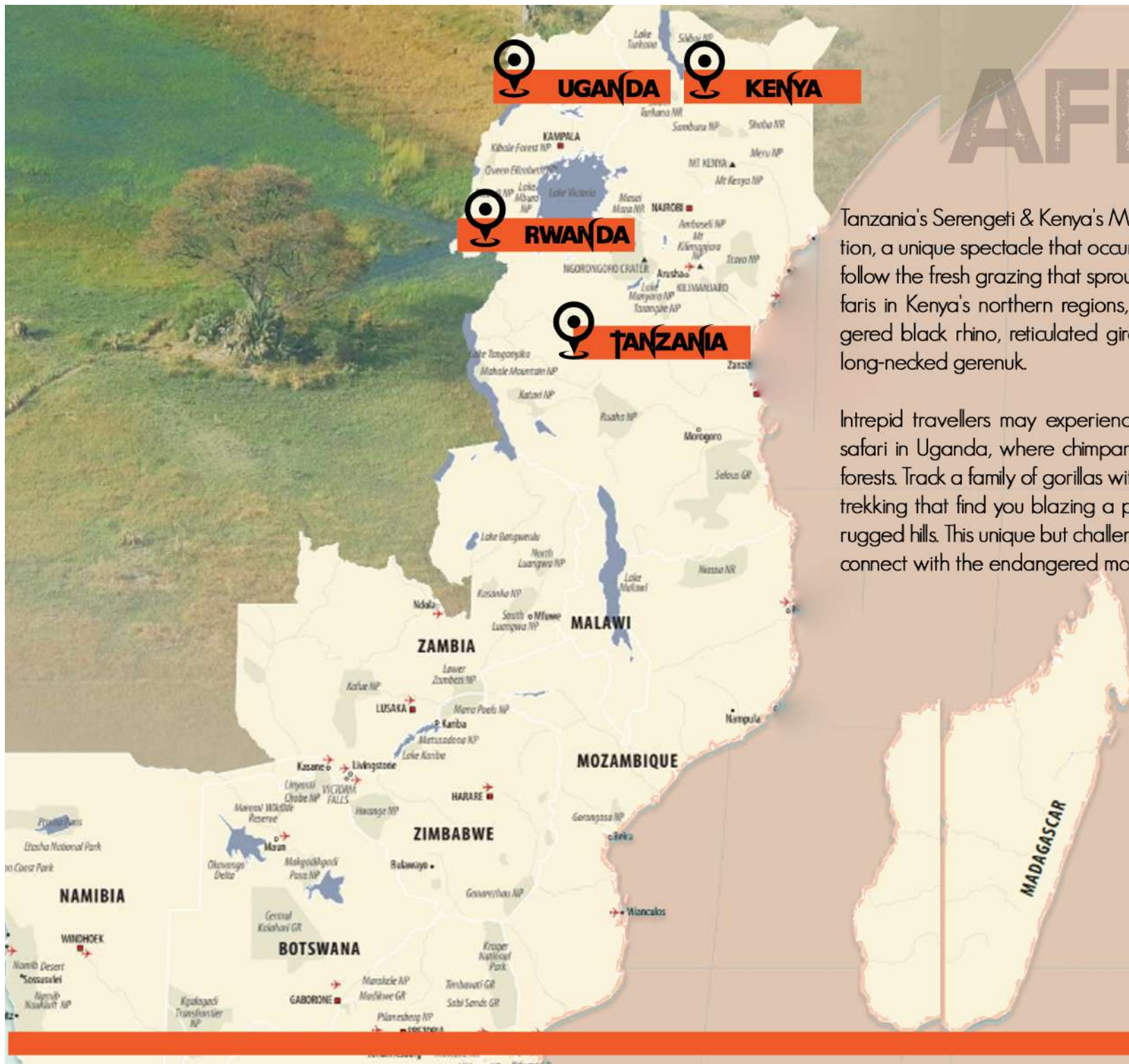
8- You have access to a video camera power socket.

10- On board HF radio communications, and Guaranteed window seating, more interior space.



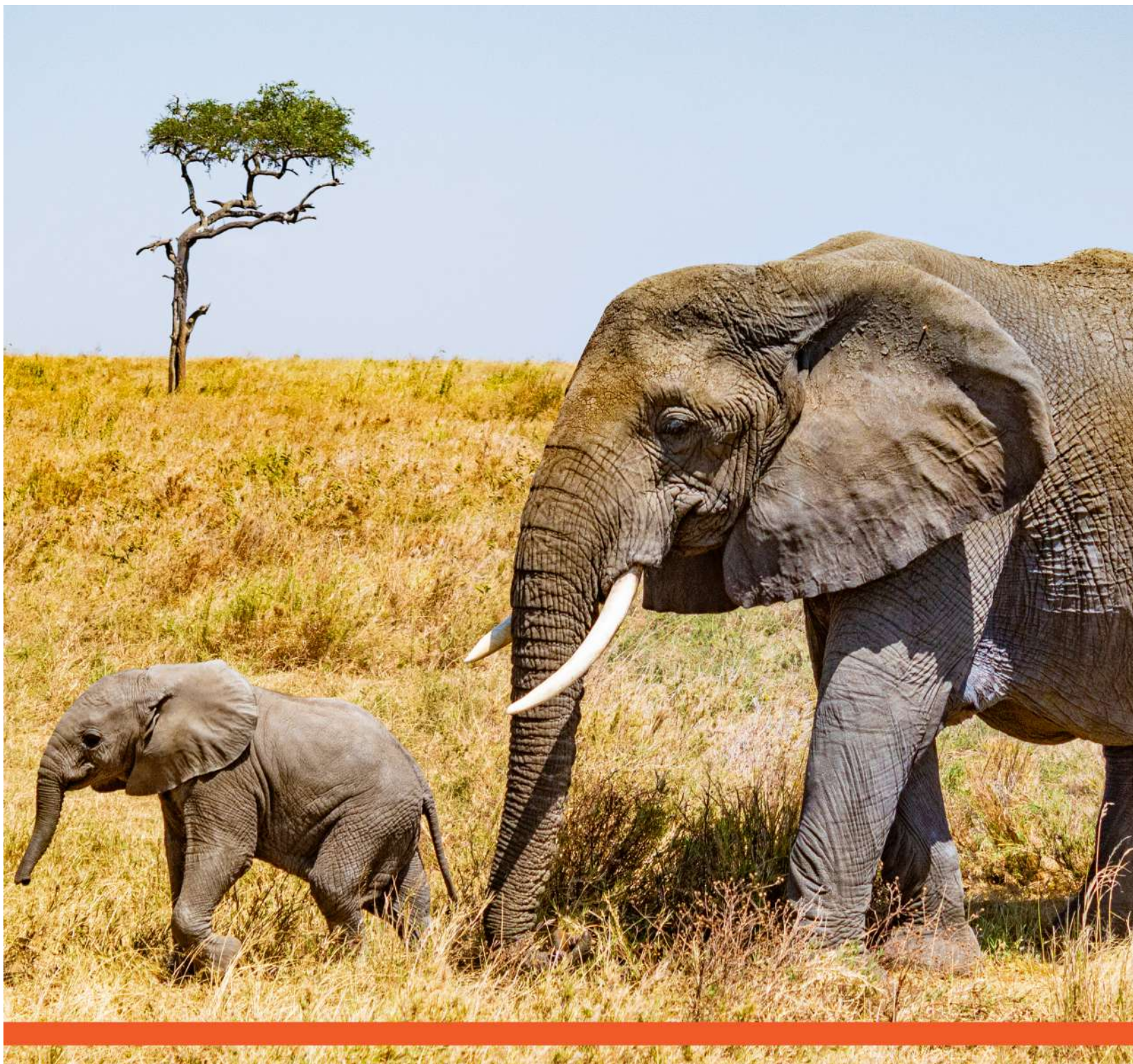
AFRICA



Tanzania's Serengeti & Kenya's Masai Mara host the annual Great Migration, a unique spectacle that occurs as huge herds of wildebeests & zebras follow the fresh grazing that sprouts in the wake of the annual rains. On safaris in Kenya's northern regions, spot local species including the endangered black rhino, reticulated giraffe, beisa oryx, Grevy's zebra and the long-necked gerenuk.

Intrepid travellers may experience a different side of East Africa with a safari in Uganda, where chimpanzees & mountain gorillas live free in the forests. Track a family of gorillas with your expert guide on two days of safari trekking that find you blazing a path through the thick forest and climbing rugged hills. This unique but challenging safari offers an unforgettable way to connect with the endangered mountain gorilla.

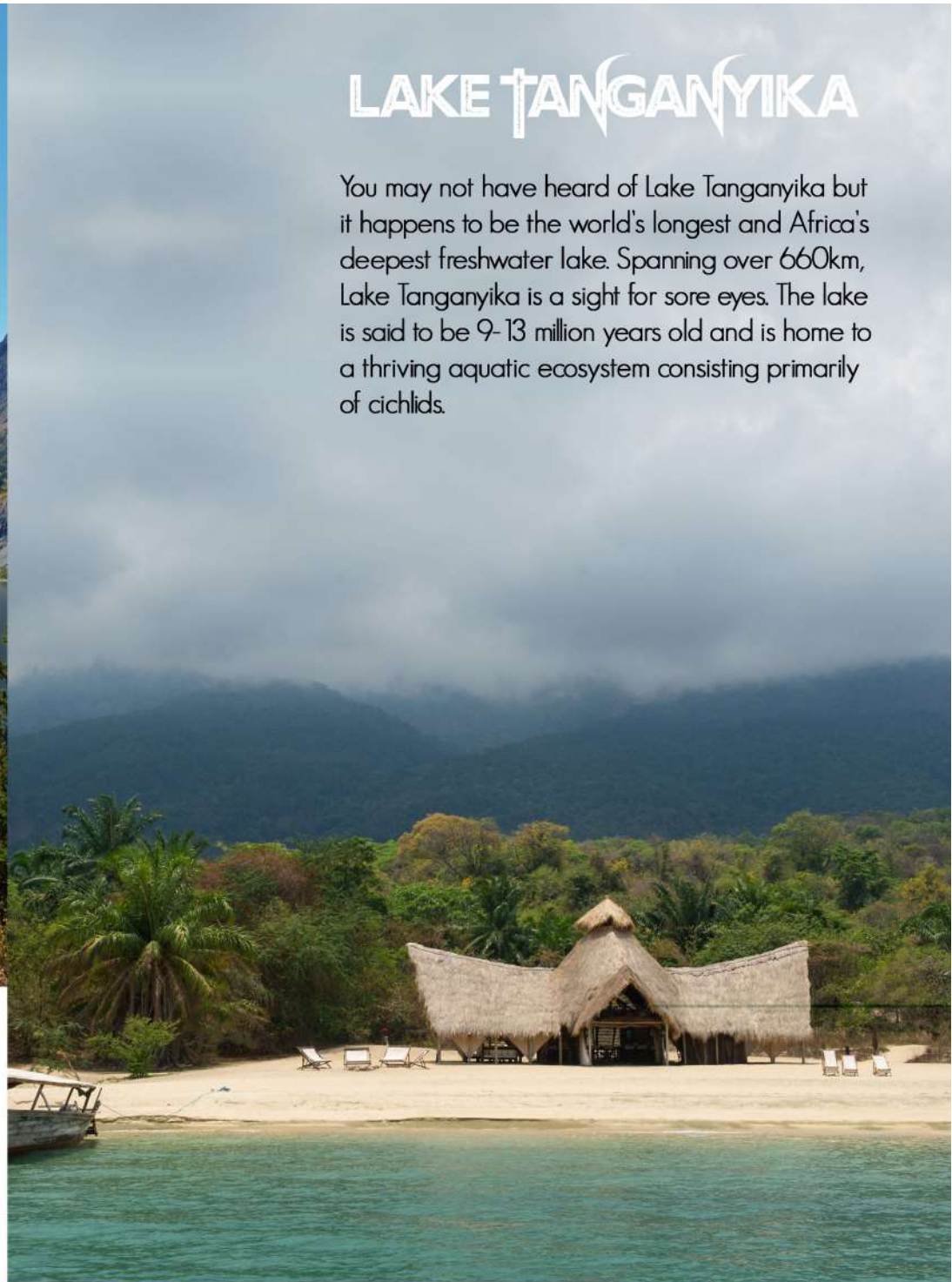


LAKE VICTORIA

Tanzania is home to numerous gorgeous and world known lakes yet, possibly the most spectacular of these is Lake Victoria. We organize lake tours and activities for those visiting and looking for something off the beaten tourist path. If that is the case, our Lake Victoria activities are highly recommended.

LAKE TANGANYIKA

You may not have heard of Lake Tanganyika but it happens to be the world's longest and Africa's deepest freshwater lake. Spanning over 660km, Lake Tanganyika is a sight for sore eyes. The lake is said to be 9-13 million years old and is home to a thriving aquatic ecosystem consisting primarily of cichlids.



VISIT KILIMANJARO

Mount Kilimanjaro, with its three volcanic cones, "Kibo", "Mawenzi", and "Shira", is a dormant volcano in Tanzania. It is the highest mountain in Africa, rising to approximately 5,895 metres above sea level. Mount Kilimanjaro national park has become one of Tanzania's most visited parks, not necessarily for its wildlife although it is there, but rather for the breathtaking views of a mountain on the equator, capped with snow, which can be climbed to stand on the top of Africa.

It is one of the continent's most magnificent sights, rising from cultivated farmlands on the lower levels, through lush rainforest to alpine meadows, and finally across a barren lunar landscape to the twin summits of Kibo and Mawenzi.

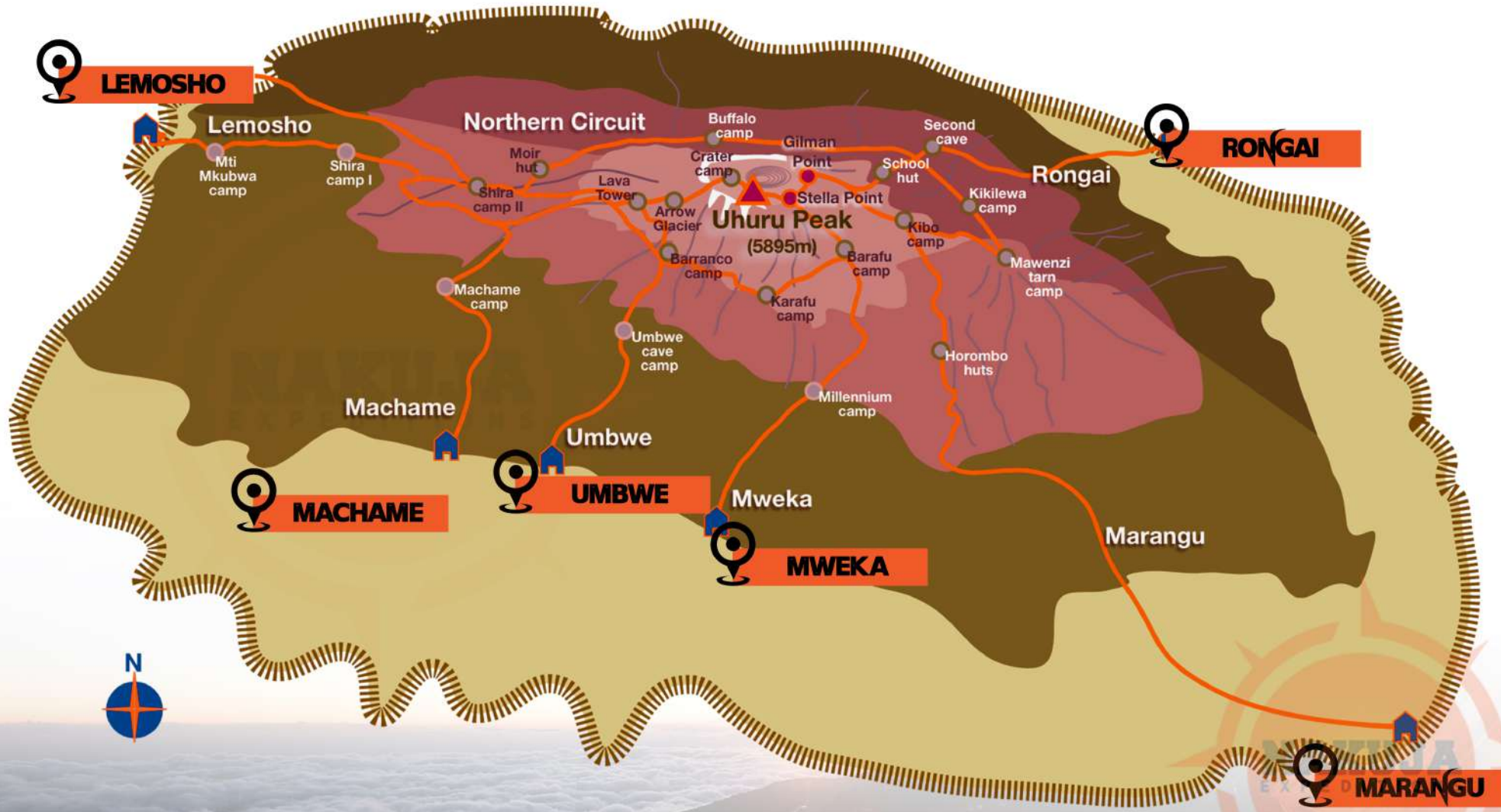
A trek up Kili lures around 25,000 trekkers each year, but is no easy task and needs serious consideration. The rewards, however, are endless throughout the expedition.

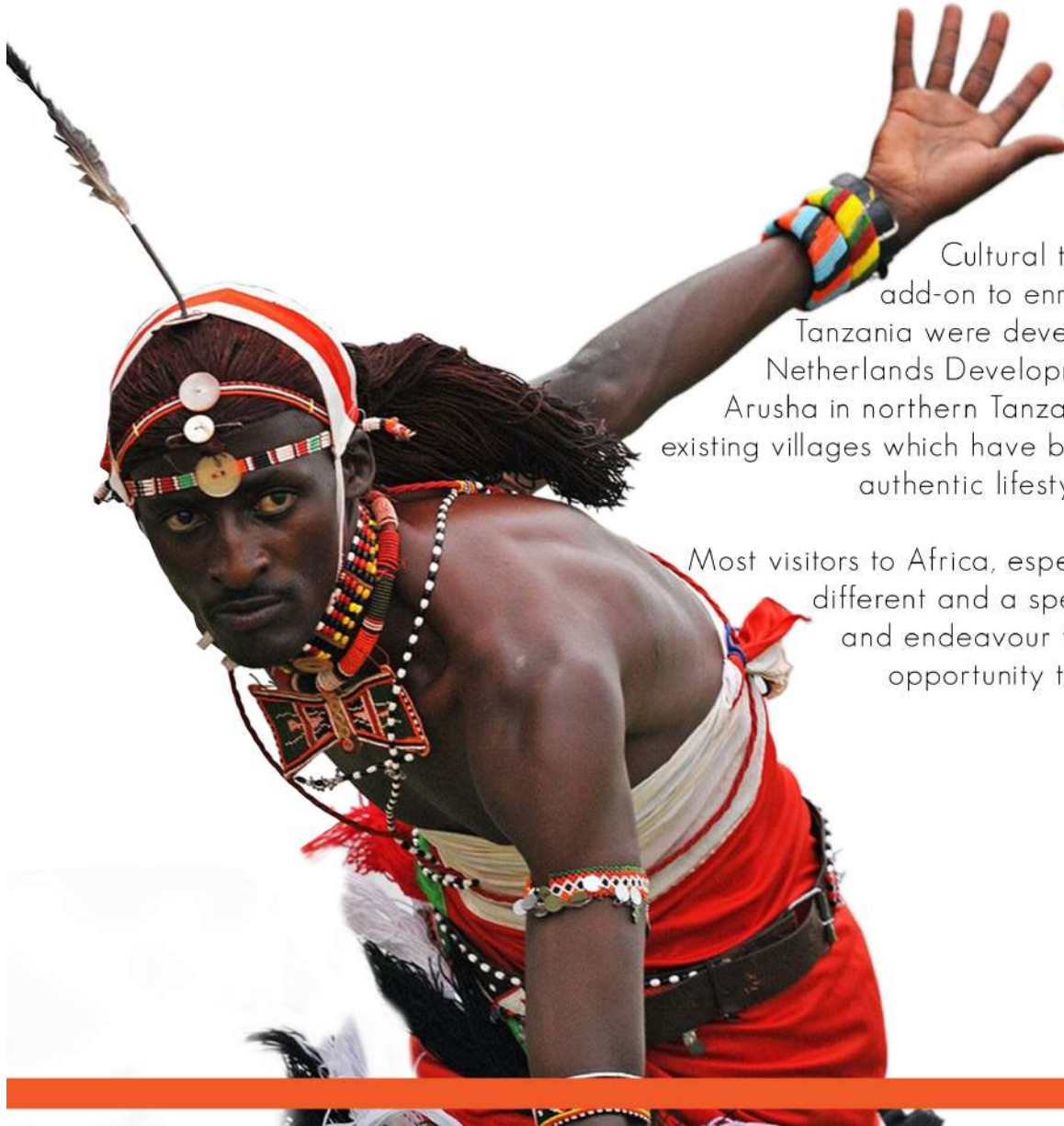
Kenya is the original safari destination, largely made up of privately-owned game reserves that allow for exclusive experiences, with long ties between the country and the British royal family. The true beauty of Kenya comes from the sheer variety of landscapes ready to be explored: from the dry deserts of Turkana in the north to Mount Kenya in the centre (the second-highest mountain in Africa) with beaches and jungles in between. Explore the rugged mountains in the north from a helicopter and then find yourself riding through the green Chyulu hills amongst some of the biggest tuskers in the world. With an incredible array of all the best wildlife in the bush to the turquoise waters of the Swahili coastline, Kenya really does have everything to offer.



Visit Rwanda to discover the land of the mountain gorilla; a country that promises the sighting of native primates surrounded by breathtaking mountainous scenery. As a country, it has overcome a genocide and is currently shifting towards eco-tourism, facing a rise in sustainable lodging, wildlife viewing and intensive animal conservation. Rwanda offers luxury accommodation, quality guiding, vast volcanic conservation areas and one of the few remaining places in the world to see mountain gorillas in their natural habitat.



Situated at the source of the River Nile, Uganda is a wild and beautiful destination offering activities for every explorer, from trekking to the mountain gorillas and chimpanzees in national parks and lush jungles, to spotting wildlife along the water's edge. With an abundance of unique wildlife and birdlife, visitors will not be disappointed by the intimate experiences of spotting primates in their natural environment - it literally took our breath away.



CULTURAL TOUR

Cultural tours are a popular product in Tanzania that is mostly sold as an add-on to enrich main safari tour programs. Most cultural tour sites in mainland Tanzania were developed by the Tanzania Tourist Board (TTB) in conjunction with the Netherlands Development Organisation (SNV), starting with selected villages around Arusha in northern Tanzania and spreading out into other areas. These are traditionally existing villages which have been made accessible to visitors who may have a glimpse of the authentic lifestyle of the more than 120 tribes in rural Tanzania.

Most visitors to Africa, especially first timers, find the continent and its people enchantingly different and a special experience. We at NakujaExpeditions appreciate this fact and endeavour to include visits to the local communities to give our guests the opportunity to see first hand the way of life in a typical African village.

VISIT ZANZIBAR
